Dear Parent/ Carer

I write to inform you that your child is permitted to wear the summer version of the school's uniform when we return from the Easter break on the 16<sup>th</sup> April. Instead of the shirt, tie and blazer, the approved white polo shirt, with two blue stripes on the collar and an embroidered school logo, may be worn. The approved school jumper may also be worn if needed but no t-shirt should be worn under the polo shirt. In addition, if school coats are worn, they must still comply with the requirements as specified on the school website i.e. they must be dark coloured and plain.

Please note that the polo shirts are available from our approved suppliers- Darren Morgan Sports in Cross Keys; AJM Embroidery in Cwmfelinfach and Jansan Wear Ltd in Aberbargoed.

Of course, pupils are welcome to continue wearing the normal school uniform, which includes the shirt, tie and an optional jumper and/ or blazer, if they wish.
