

## Rewards and Sanctions - Breakdown

Islwyn High School uses a points system for Achievement Awards and Behaviour Sanctions. The following list gives you a breakdown of how the points are awarded and their value:

<b>Award name</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Value</b>
R1	Good Pupil effort in class	+3
R2	Worthy of praise – above and beyond what is expected	+5
Positive note home	Exceptional behaviour/work	+10
Positive phone call home	Exceptional behaviour/work	+20
Weekly bonus – Full	100% attendance for week with no sanctions	+20
Weekly bonus - Half	90% attendance for week (1day off) with no sanction points	+10

<b>Behaviour name</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Value</b>
Chewing Gum	Pupil is seen chewing gum within the school grounds	-5
Truancy	Absent from lesson or off site	-10
Incorrect Equipment	Missing pens, books etc	-1
Incomplete Homework	Homework not completed by deadline	-2
Late	Late to lessons	-1
No Planner	No planner available in lessons	-1
S1 - Sanction	Inappropriate behaviour – time out	-3
S2 – Sanction	Inappropriate behaviour - relocation	-5
Incorrect uniform	Incorrect uniform worn or item missing	-1
Dropping litter	Litter dropped within the school ground	-5
Use of Mobile Phone	Mobile phone visible in school	-5
