## TRIP SAFETY PROCEDURES



The accompanying staff wish your child to have an enjoyable and safe trip. To this end there are a number of safety procedures in place for the trip:

- 1. The party leader has developed comprehensive risk assessment procedures for all aspects of the trip. These outline the likely risks and the detailed measures in place to mitigate against them.
- 2. The trip includes 'first aid' trained staff and the party carries comprehensive first aid and medical kit.
- 3. All pupils are fully briefed regarding the trips 'golden rules' to ensure both good behaviour and pupil safety.
- 4. The trip operates a 'pairs' ruling, a buddy system whereby pupils always have at least one partner with them at all times.
- 5. Pupils have control of their OWN room key and have access to their OWN ROOM ONLY for both privacy and personal safety.
- 6. Pupils belong to 'Staff groups' where a member of staff acts as first point of contact in case of difficulty and looks after the majority of pupils' money. Pupils access a daily allowance at afternoon tea.
- 7. Ski instruction is only with the licensed local ski school and pupils are placed within appropriate ability groups.
- 8. Ski equipment is of a very high standard lessening the potential effect of equipment failure.
- 9. Pupil / Instructor ratios are from 1:12
