Good attitude

What should I do as a Parent, following a report?

Firstly, discuss the report as a whole with your child.

- Discuss any subject issues, ask them how they feel they are doing in the subject and why they think they are on/below their "benchmark". If the child knows why and is working to improve this area, then monitor the situation or contact your child's teacher if you require more information.
- If your child has done well, then praise and reward as appropriate
- Reports are discussed and self reflection is completed as part of the tutor time.
- Your child may also receive additional support.



Academic Tracking & Intervention

Tracking, intervention and support programmes can be put in place to ensure that all students achieve their potential.

Pupil progress is monitored, after each set of reports and after any assessments or exams.

There is targeted, individual intervention for pupils not meeting their own personal required standards.
